Management System for Asset Management

This International Standard specifies the requirements for the establishment, implementation, maintenance and improvement of a management system for asset management, referred to as an "asset management system".*

* from ISO 55001





Asset Management System

Set of interrelated and interacting elements of an organization, whose function is to establish the **asset management policy** and **asset management objectives**, and the processes needed to achieve those objectives*



* from ISO 55000



Asset Management System?

Set of interrelated and interacting elements of an organization, whose function is to establish the asset management policy and asset management objectives, and the processes needed to achieve those objectives*



* NOT from ISO 55000



- ISO 55001 describes management system for asset management
- ISO 55001 does NOT describe a management system for assets
- It is NOT about managing assets
- It is about Asset Management





Value from Assets

Asset is an item, thing or entity that has potential or actual value to an organization*

The challenge has been how to reveal that value *from ISO 55000

Value is a highly complex topic

Value is an expression of achievement of organizational objectives

- In for-profit organizations the objective is:
 - \$\$\$
 - Or triple bottom line: people, profit, and planet
 - Or a newer, better approach
- In not-for-profits and governments, the objective is:
 - Policy and programs

Asset Leadership

Planning and directing the activity of an organization to realize value from assets in achieving the mission and objectives of the organization

Asset Leadership connects the organizational objectives to the asset management objectives







Significance

- Asset Leadership connects Asset Management to the larger organization and to organizational mission and objectives
- Asset related decisions can be made based on organizational mission and objectives
 - A focus on moving people rather than a focus on building roads or tunnels or airplanes
