APL Defines Enterprise Asset Management


- A practice that oversees assets throughout the life-cycle process

- Does not include:
 - People
 - > Space allocation
 - Building
 - Space location fit-up
 - Cash and investments





Traditional Methods Result in Mixed Age Data







- Inaccurate

Parametric Approach

Supporting Outcomes not Perfection

- Some assets require sensor-driven data and predictive analytics
 - Uberlytics Criticality Analyzer
- Some assets require the full engineering assessment approach.
- In MOST cases, Asset Management sufferes under the burden of data that is too perfect and too old.
- Parametric Approaches are fast, inexpensive and accessible.
