

What is the Yellow Book?




- Used by auditors of government entities, entities that receive government awards, and other audit organizations performing Yellow Book audits.
- Outlines the requirements for audit reports, professional qualifications for auditors, and audit organization quality control.
- Auditors of federal, state, and local government programs use these standards to perform their audits and produce their reports.
