**Asset Management Tidbits #24**

**Top Management:** person or group of people who directs and controls an *organization* at the highest level.

Top management is responsible for developing the asset management policy and asset management objectives and for aligning them with the organizational objectives. Top management should create the vision and values that guide policy, practice and actively promote these values inside and outside the organization. Top management also defines the responsibilities, accountabilities and asset management objectives and strategies, which create the environment for the asset management system. .

# ISO 55000 – US Technical Advisory Group (TAG)

**US Technical Advisory Group  
To ISO/TC 251**

Operating Procedures for the United States (U.S.) Technical Advisory Group to ISO/TC 251 Asset Management Systems: 2018

**A1 General.** These procedures for the U.S. Technical Advisory Group (U.S. TAG) to ISO Technical Committee 251 (hereafter referred to as "the TAG") meet the requirements for due process and coordination in the development of U.S. positions for ISO activities as stated in "ANSI Procedures For U.S. Participation in the International Standards Activities of ISO". The TAG consists of its members and its U.S. TAG administrator (hereafter referred to as "the TAG administrator"). This TAG is related to ISO Technical Committee (TC) 251 on Asset Management.

Subgroups of the TAG may be formed to relate to the subcommittees of ISO/TC 251.


**A2 Goal of the TC.** The adoption of standardization in the field of asset management (generic asset management systems and supporting technologies) and to ensure the needs and views of the United States are expressed and included in the development of international standards on asset management.

**A3 Mission Statement.** To develop, support, promote, and steward asset management standards. To help maximize the application of management systems for asset management by participating in the development of guidance articles and knowledge content and to contribute to the development of technical specifications.

**A4 Functions and Responsibilities.** The functions and responsibilities of the TAG are:


1. Develop and determine the U.S. position on recommended additions, changes, and revisions to the ISO55000 series of Asset Management Standards and supporting documents.
2. Represent the U.S. on activities to revise the existing ISO55000 series of Asset Management Standards (ISO 55000, 55001, and 55002) and create as well as manage new standards, technical specifications, and guidance in the ISO 55000 series.
3. Act as a liaison between ANSI and entities that adopt the ISO 55000 series of Asset Management Standards.
4. Continue to grow and cultivate the national understanding, use, and implementation, of the ISO 55000 series of Asset Management Standards to advance effective asset management.
5. Promote the ISO 55000 series of Asset Management Standards to organizations, individuals, and other entities that may impact, be impacted, or should be impacted by the Standard.
6. Initiate and approve U.S. New Work Item Proposals (NWIP) for submission by ANSI for consideration by an ISO technical committee or subcommittee that relates to ISO 55000.
7. Initiate and approve U.S. working drafts related to ISO 55000 for submission by ANSI to ISO technical committees or subcommittees (and, where appropriate, working groups) for consideration as committee drafts.
