The Asset Leadership Network would like to recognize the National Guard Bureau and the Army National Guard for demonstrated leadership in asset management developing the Readiness Center Transformation Master Plan. This plan was developed in response to critical national needs recognized in Congressional Directive 111-201 developed by the Senate Armed Services Committee. The National Guard Bureau recognized the answer to transform the 70 million square foot Army National Guard Readiness Center portfolio across the country required more than a traditional master plan. It required an asset management approach that evaluated the contribution this infrastructure makes to Army National Guard capabilities supporting both domestic and federal missions. The ground-breaking analysis methodology developed to achieve this used asset management principles to evaluate life cycle investments foremost based on their contribution to Army National Guard readiness. This changed the narrative of the \$28B / 15-year national master plan from investing in Readiness Centers to investing in Army National Guard Readiness. The outcome was not only a range of investment strategies to help inform Congressional decision makers on the balance between risk and capabilities given a range of investment strategies, but also simplified understandings on how investments in Army National Guard Readiness Centers will lead to a more capable Army National Guard and resilient America.
